▶ Nighthawk MK63 Setup Guide

This is how you would generally set up the MK63:

- Take the main router out of the box and connect it. Use an Ethernet wire to connect the Nighthawk router to your modem. Turn it on. Wait for the LED to stop blinking.
- Put the satellites in place. Don't think too hard about it. Start with one that is midway between the router and a room where the WiFi signal is poor. Put it in. The LED should automatically sync.
- Get the Nighthawk app, which works on both iOS and Android. This will help you with the rest.



- Follow the instructions; the app will guide you through each step. It will ask for your password and network name (SSID). You may either maintain the settings or alter them.

- Check the signal: After you've connected, go around the home with your phone. You may need to move one of the satellites if you encounter a dead place.

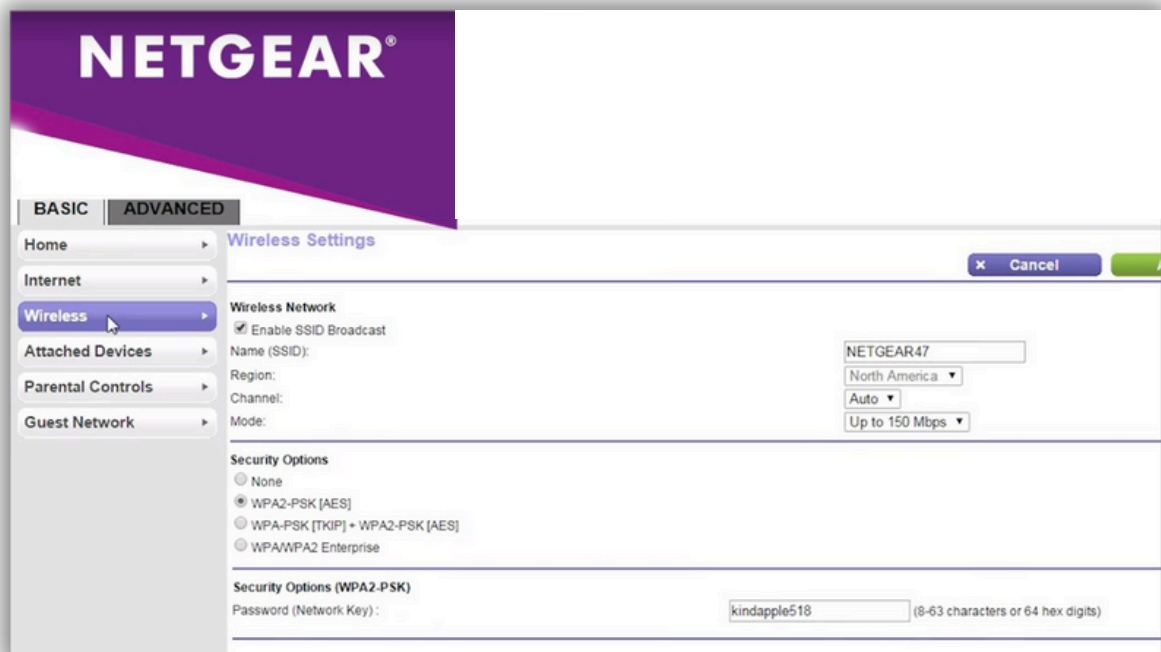
That's all there is to it. It's not as easy as plugging in a phone charger, but it's not that hard either.

Nighthawk MK63 Setup via Browser

You may also set up MK63 via a web browser. If you have a problem with the app, this can take a bit longer, but it works.

- Connect the primary router to your modem with an Ethernet connection and turn it on. Wait for the light to stop blinking.
- Link your PC. You may accomplish this via WiFi (the default network will show up as "NETGEAR" or something like that) or by connecting it straight into Ethernet.
- It doesn't matter whether you open your browser using Chrome, Edge, or Safari. Type routerlogin.net into the address bar. or 192.168.1.1. Don't look it up, just write it.
- It will prompt you to create an admin username and password the first time you use it. This is not the same as your WiFi password.

- Nighthawk MK63 Setup includes selecting a WiFi name (SSID), password, and connecting satellites.
- After you set up the router, plug in the satellites one at a time. They should connect on their own, but if they don't, you may do it via the browser menu.
- Save your settings, restart your computer if you need to, and then walk about your home to see whether you have coverage.
